Over the last few years we have seen around 5000 people attend the event on the day, mainly families. ## Terms and Conditions for Stall Holders

a) The full address of the venue of the event is:

Cromer Street, King's Cross, London WC1H 8DU Nearest Tube: King's Cross

Buses: 38, 73, 30, 205, 17, 91, 214, 46, 259, 390, 10

- b) The Islamic Mela promotes an Islamic Ethos and all Stall holders and their staffs are required to abide by the Islamic Principles of social and economic activity, indeed as well as spirit.
- c) No activity can be done that contradicts the norms of the Islamic Shari'ah. In the unlikely event of any disputes, the organisers of the Islamic Mela will have the final say.
- d) The stalls we provide are 6'x 3' wooden trestle tables; we do not provide cloth or coverings for stall. We just provide a standalone stall table and foldable chair, you can bring your own cloth and marquees/tents provided they cover just the stall table area, no extra stalls, or stands can be brought to the event due to lack of space. You can bring cloth rails but they must stay within the stall area.
- e) You can unload your cars from 8:00 am to 10:00 am, you will **not** be able to park on Cromer Street but free parking is available on Sundays in the surrounding streets.
- f) The price of hiring a stall is £60.00 per stall whatever product or service you provide. If you book 3 or more stalls, you will get £5 discount on each of the stalls. So the total cost of 3 stalls will be £165 instead of £180
- g) The payment of the stall has to be made in advance otherwise we cannot guarantee you a space.
- h) All stall holders who wish to sell food will need to provide a valid Food & Hygiene Certificate
- i) The stalls are booked on a first come basis.
- j) You are required to accept the stall position which you are allocated; there will be different areas for different stalls.
- k) Displays must be confined to the stall space and should not extend into the road; this is for reasons of public safety and access.
- I) No electricity will be provided to any stall holders.
- m) All stallholders are responsible for cleaning up the rubbish of their stall at the end of the day.
- n) Stall fees will ONLY be refunded if the event is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances and if there is any other Islamic legal cause.
- o) Any damage to the stall or chair provided, the stallholder will be charged and expected to pay on the day.
- p) All stallholders are expected to return the chair provided and not pass them onto anyone else.
